Waste and Disposal Information

Trash disposal is a community concern. **Help us** keep our community looking first-class!

What you can do to help:

1. Garbage

Picked up every Thursday. If the trash bins are full please hold at home until you can dispose of waste properly.

2. Recycling - <https://www.highpointnc.gov/647/Recycling-Guidelines>

Picked up **every other** Thursday. Don't put recyclables into bags, leave unbound and place in the green bin. Know what is 'recyclable' by the City of High Point.

3. Bulk Disposal - <https://www.highpointnc.gov/530/Bulky-Items-Pickup>

Pickup is **every other** Thursday, same as Recyclables. Bulk items are to be placed on the curb **the day before** a scheduled pickup. Know what is considered 'Bulk' for pickup.

4. Yard Waste

Yard waste is picked up every Thursday. **The city will no longer pick up yard waste in plastic bags.**

Following are important guidelines:

Garbage:

Household waste is to be placed in the brown bins.

- **DO NOT PUT CONSTRUCTION WASTE IN THE TRASH BINS!** The city will reject collecting the trash from the container. Homeowners are responsible for advising any work crews they may employ of this restriction. Violations may incur a removal charge to the offending homeowner by the city.
- On holiday weeks like Christmas and New Years, the collection schedule will run one day later.

Recycling:

A big problem is the wrongful use of the recycling bins. Know what is recyclable. Not all items that can be recycled are accepted by the City of High Point. Please review the attached flyer.

Return plastic grocery bags to the store and wire hangers to the dry cleaners.

- **ELECTRONICS - DO NOT** put electronic materials in the garbage bins. Take the electronics to either of the locations below:
 - (1) City of High Point Material Recovery Facility:
5875 Riverdale Drive, Jamestown. Open 8am - 4:30pm Monday – Thursday
 - (2) Unmanned Drop-off Trailer at Ingleside Compost Facility:
3001 Ingleside Drive, High Point. Open M-F 8am - 4pm and Sat. 9am - 1pm
- **STYROFOAM** - Clean dry Styrofoam (no peanuts, plastic or bubble wrap) may be taken to trailers at:
 - (1) High Point Public Library:
901 N Main St, High Point available 24/7
 - (2) Unmanned Drop-off Trailer at Ingleside Compost Facility:
3001 Ingleside Dr, High Point M-F 8am – 4pm and Sat. 9am – 1pm
- **HAZARDOUS WASTE** – Ecoflo, Inc., 2750 Patterson St., Greensboro
M-F 10am – 6pm and Sat. 8am – 2pm

Bulk Pickup:

Bulk pickup items should be placed on the curb in front of your house **the day before the scheduled bulk pickup.**

You can take your bulk items to the landfill.

M-F 7:30am - 4:30pm and Sat. 7:30am - 1pm

Yard Waste:

The City of High Point will pick up yard waste that is in bins that can be purchased from the city or the paper bags that can be purchased from Lowe’s, Home Depot or other such stores. They will also pick up limbs that are bundled and tied and no heavier than 50 pounds and no longer than 4 feet. **The bins, bags and bundles may be placed on the curb the day before pick up.** Know what is considered ‘Yard Waste’.

Dead plants (without pots) can be disposed of this way. Do not put ANY plant material in the *garbage or recycling containers*, or the City will reject the entire container.

Large amounts of yard waste can be taken for free to the Ingleside Composting Site, 3001 Ingleside Drive, High Point.

Violation notices, which can turn into fines by the city, may be sent to offenders of the trash rules.
